



THINGS NEEDED FOR GRADES 5 & 6

To be placed inside the bag or to be checked/collected by the subject teacher

10 Thick COMPOSITION NOTEBOOKS w/ plastic cover

Cover and label the notebooks with the ff:

White -	Reminder Notebook
Red -	Language
Pink -	Reading
Orange -	Araling Panlipunan
Yellow -	Filipino
Green -	Math
Blue -	Science
Brown -	Christian Living Education
Violet -	Special Subjects
Green -	Math Graphing Notebook

To be placed inside the bag and to be brought regularly/daily.

- ruler 1 ft
- eraser
- glue stick
- small sharpener
- scissors
- 2 pcs mongol pencil #2
- 1 pc ordinary black, blue, and red ballpen
- protractor
- crayons

EMERGENCY KIT: (to be stored in the basket)
scarf, whistle, small betadine, flashlight, band aid alcohol, gauze pad, cotton, first-aid paper tape
N.B. Everything should fit inside a pouch/small bag. Label with name and section.

GROOMING KIT: (to be placed inside the bag)
cologne, face towel, wet wipes, small soap, hand sanitizer, toothbrush & toothpaste, comb

To be collected/checked by the adviser:

- 1 plastic blue basket for books
- 1 intermediate pad (whole)
- 1 intermediate pad (lengthwise)
- 1 intermediate pad (crosswise)
- 1 long folder
- 3 rolls – tissue paper
- 1 pc bookend for cubbyhole
- 10 pcs oslo paper
- 10 pcs construction paper
- whiteboard marker | whiteboard eraser
- white board 5.5" x 8.5" (*shall be stored in the cubbyhole*)
- 4 pcs 1x1 ID picture
- 4 pcs 2x2 ID picture

Required materials for different subjects:

- 1 short red clearbook – for English journals
- 1 long yellow clearbook – for CLED portfolio
- 1 long folder with name and section for Computer activities

REQUIREMENTS FOR CONFIRMATION (for Grade 6 students only)

Birth Certificate NSO (2018 issued – original and photocopy)
Baptismal Certificate (2018 issued - original and photocopy with a stated purpose for Confirmation)

REMINDERS:

1. Label all materials and books with student's name. Please **DO NOT WRITE** the name of the section and adviser as they are still tentative.
2. Bags with rollers are not allowed.
3. On the **FIRST DAY** of classes, let your child bring a small bag containing the following:
