8 Thick WRITING NOTEBOOKS w/ PLASTIC COVER

Cover and Label the Notebooks with the ff:

White -	Reminder Notebook
Red -	English
Green -	Math
Orange -	Araling Panlipunan
Yellow -	Filipino
Light Blue -	Science
Dark Blue -	Music
Brown -	Christian Living Education

1 spelling booklet
1 short red clearbook – for English journals
1 long yellow clearbook – for CLED portfolio
1 long folder with plastic cover and fastener
(properly labeled with name and section)
10 pcs long bond paper
2 pcs mongol pencil #2
ruler 1 ft
eraser
glue stick
small sharpener
scissors
crayons
whiteboard marker
whiteboard eraser,
white board 5.5” x 8.5” (shall be stored in the cubbyhole)
1 pc ordinary red ballpen

TO BE COLLECTED/CHECKED BY THE ADVISER

1 plastic blue basket for books
3 pads (Grade 1 or 2 pad paper)
1 long folder with plastic cover
3 rolls – tissue paper
1 pc bookend for cubbyhole for Grade 2 only
10 pcs oslo paper
10 pcs construction paper

GROOMING KIT: (to be stored in the cubbyhole)
shorts, t-shirt, underwear, face towel, wet wipes,
small soap, hand sanitizer, toothbrush & paste,
comb
N.B. Place everything in a short thick plastic envelope. Label with name and section.

EMERGENCY KIT: (to be stored in the basket)
scarf, whistle, small betadine, flashlight, band aid
alcohol, gauze pad, cotton, first-aid paper tape
N.B. Everything should fit inside a pouch/small bag. Label with name and section.

REMINDERS:

1. Label all materials and books with students' name. Please **DO NOT WRITE** the name of the section and adviser as they are still tentative.
2. Bags with rollers are not allowed.
3. On the **FIRST DAY** of classes, let your child bring a small bag containing the following:
 - a. Reminder Notebook
 - b. sharpened pencil and eraser
 - c. snacks and drinks (water or juice). **NO JUNK FOOD.**
4. Materials to be collected by the adviser must be brought on the **SECOND DAY** of classes.
5. All books, notebooks and other materials should already be complete by the **SECOND WEEK** of classes.
