GROOMING KIT: (to be stored in the cubbyhole)

EMERGENCY KIT: (to be stored in the basket)
scarf, whistle, small betadine, flashlight, band aid
alcohol, gauze pad, cotton, first-aid paper tape
*N.B. Everything should fit inside a pouch/small
bag. Label with name and section*

Baptismal Certificate (2016 issued – original and
photocopy)

REMINDERS:

1. Label all materials and books with students' name. Please DO NOT WRITE the name of the section and adviser as they are still tentative.
2. Bags with rollers are not allowed.
3. On the FIRST DAY of classes, let your child bring a small bag containing the following:
 - a. Reminder Notebook
 - b. sharpened pencil and eraser
 - c. snacks and drinks (water or juice). NO JUNK FOOD.
4. Materials to be collected by the adviser must be brought on the SECOND DAY of classes.
