**GUIDELINES AND RULES FOR THE SUMMER ENRICHMENT PROGRAM 2016  
(For incoming Grade 11 students under STEM)**

In preparation for the roll-out of senior high school this coming school year, the office for Mastery and Enrichment Learning Program (MELP) shall hold a **free summer enrichment class in Math and Science for incoming Grade 11 students under the Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) strand.** The said course offerings aim to cover and enrich selected topics in junior high school deemed as prerequisite for STEM applied tracks such as Pre-Calculus, Basic Calculus, Biology, General Chemistry, General Physics, Statistics and Probability and General Math. **These classes are mandatory for students who have enrolled in LSQC for Grade 11 under the STEM strand on or before May 6, 2016.**

**REMINDERS**

1. Students who have enrolled for Grade 11 STEM on or before **May 6, 2016** are entitled to attend this class.
2. Students must come to class on time. They are expected to be in the classroom once the bell is rung to signal the beginning of classes.
3. Students shall be using the current school ID (SY 2015- 2016). An additional SEP ID will be issued during the first day of classes to be attached to their current ID. The ID shall be worn at all times inside the campus and shall be presented to the guard upon entry and exit of the campus.
4. Students shall be wearing the proper civilian attire. Strictly prohibited are shorts, slippers/sandals and sleeveless shirts for both males and females. Likewise, students are not allowed to have their hair dyed with another color.
5. Students are required to bring the ff.: scientific calculator, periodic table of elements and notebook (standard size).
6. Students are not allowed to go out of the campus to have lunch. They may opt to bring their own food or buy at the canteen.
7. Cellular phones and other similar communication equipment/ gadgets are not allowed in school.
8. A student who has successfully met and fulfilled all requirements earning a passing mark at the end of the program shall receive a certificate of completion. Likewise, a certificate shall also be given to the student who has earned the highest grade in both subjects. Certificates will also be given to those who have earned perfect attendance.
